

Advanced Science Young Researcher Award is Now Open for Applications!

Dear Professors,

The 2024 Advanced Science Young Researcher Award is now open for applications!

The Advanced Science Young Researcher Award recognizes outstanding, interdisciplinary scientific work in the fundamental understanding and applied development of materials science, physics, chemistry, medical and life sciences, and engineering by a young scientist or engineer. The award recipient must also show exceptional promise as a developing research leader.

Award

Three researchers will be selected, and each of them will be awarded a certificate and \$1,000. The 2024 award is supported by Wiley and will be issued on July 13, 2024 during the Advanced Science/VIEW Symposium 2024 AND 2nd International Symposium on Materiobiology in Shanghai, China (July 12-14, 2024).

Eligibility and selection criteria

1. The applicant shall not have reached his/her 45th birthday by the time the award is received (July 13, 2024).
2. The award will be presented to individual researchers who have conducted best-in-class fundamental and applied research in materials science, physics, chemistry, medical and life sciences, and engineering.
3. The award winner will be selected based on the outstanding quality, novelty, and significance of the candidate's research.
4. The publications of the applicant are not limited to a specific journal.

Application Process

Applications for the "Advanced Science Young Researcher Award" must be submitted directly to advancedscience@wiley.com with the email subject of "AS Young Award 2024" by **May 23, 2024**. Peer- and organizational- nominations are welcome, subject to the nominee agreeing to the nomination.

The submitted application materials must include:

- (1) An application letter and research summary statement highlighting key research discoveries and their impact (1 page)
- (2) Curriculum Vitae (2-pages maximum) including the date of birth and latest photograph
- (3) List of significant publication history (2-pages maximum)
- (4) Letters of support from one or more established scientists familiar with the applicant's qualifications and area of research.

Please combine all the application materials into one file.

The decision of the award committee is final, and no enquiries will be entertained.
